

## Accelerated Reader Guidelines

Listed below are the grade level requirements determined by the teachers for the Accelerated Reader program.

### Grade 3 –

Students are to take two (2) Accelerated Reader tests per quarter. The books they test on for Accelerated Reader may also be used for Book-It, book reports, book projects, etc.

### Grade 4 –

Students are to take two (2) Accelerated Reader tests per quarter. The fourth graders write a monthly book report. Students may use the same Accelerated Reader book they tested on for those monthly book reports. If the teacher reads an AR book to the class, the whole class may take the AR test for that book which then gives them added points toward the certification levels.

### Grade 5 –

The teachers require a written book report on a theme every other month. For example, in September the students are reading a mystery book. The students may use an Accelerated Reader book for any of the themes. Another option would be for them to read an Accelerated Reader book during the months book reports are not required. The requirement is to take four (4) Accelerated Reader tests per year.

### Grades 6-8 (Junior High) –

Students are encouraged to participate in the Accelerated Reader program by reading Accelerated Reader books for extra credit.
