

**ALL SAINTS OF ST. JOHN VIANNEY SCHOOL
UNIFORM POLICY FOR 2017-2018 (AS OF 4.25.17)**

Students are expected to dress in an appropriate manner that is comfortable yet maintains the spiritual, educational, and social environment of All Saints School. It is imperative that students abide by the dress code from the time they arrive on campus until they leave the building after school. Students violating the dress code will receive a dress code violation and may be asked to change before attending class. **The administration has final say concerning the dress code. Parents are depended upon to see that the dress code is observed at all times.**

New fashions and trends sometimes pose questions as to whether they are consistent with the uniform policy. **Please refer to this policy BEFORE purchasing such items. Questions may also be referred to the administration.** Additions or changes to this policy may be made at any time.

GRADES 1-5 BOYS' DRESS CODE

Pants: Navy dress twill pants. (No cords or cargo pants)

Shirt: White knit polo shirt, long or short sleeve in white.

Only plain **white** T-shirts may be worn underneath. All boys' shirts are to be tucked in.

Shoes: Appropriate school dress shoes must be worn. Neutral colors that coordinate with the uniform (no neon; solid color preferred.) Sandals, flip flops, clogs, and moccasins are **NOT** permitted.

NO athletic shoes, October 1st - April 30th. (except for gym and dress down days)

Socks: Solid color navy, white, gray or black. At least quarter length. **Fully covering the ankle.**

GRADES 6-8 BOYS' DRESS CODE

Pants: Navy dress twill pants. (No cords or cargo pants)

Belt: Solid color (brown, black, or navy). No metal studs or designs of any kind.

Shirt: Knit (khaki) shirt, short sleeve, with All Saints screened on left chest of shirt. **(Must be purchased through Schoolbelles)**

Only plain **white** T-shirts may be worn underneath. All boys' shirts are to be tucked in.

Shoes: Appropriate school dress shoes must be worn. Neutral colors that coordinate with the uniform (no neon; solid color preferred.) Sandals, flip flops, clogs, and moccasins are **NOT** permitted.

NO athletic shoes, October 1st - April 30th. (except for gym and dress down days)

Socks: Solid color navy, white, gray or black. At least quarter length. **Fully covering the ankle.**

GRADES 1-5 GIRLS' DRESS CODE

Jumper: V-neck, pleated, blue/grey plaid jumper. (Schoolbelles) Not be more than two inches above the knee.

Pants: Navy Schoolbelles or Dockers. (No cords or cargo pants)

Shirt: White blouse with round or pointed collar, long or short sleeve.

Socks/tights: Solid color white, navy, grey, or black. At least quarter length. **Fully covering the ankle.**

Shoes: Appropriate school dress shoes must be worn. Neutral colors that coordinate with the uniform (no neon; solid color preferred.) Sandals, flip flops, clogs, and moccasins are **NOT** permitted.

Sandals, flip flops, clogs, moccasin, open-toed shoes, shoes without a back or heels **higher than one inch are NOT permitted.**

NO athletic Shoes, October 1st - April 30th. (except for gym and dress down days)

GRADES 6-8 GIRLS' DRESS CODE

Skirt: Schoolbelles - flat front skort style #1535, value skort #3269, side pleat skort #1533 and value pleated tab skooter #8469, Skorts may not be more than two inches above the knee. Skirts may not be rolled.

Slacks: Navy Schoolbelles or Dockers. (No cords or cargo pants)

Blouse: White overblouse long or short sleeve. Only **plain white** undergarments may be worn underneath.

Sock/tights: Solid color white, navy, grey, or black. At least quarter length. **Fully covering the ankle.**

Tights must be worn from September to April - (Solid color white, navy, grey or black- no rips.)

Shoes: Appropriate school dress shoes must be worn. Neutral colors that coordinate with the uniform (no neon; solid color preferred.) Sandals, flip flops, clogs, moccasin, open-toed shoes, shoes without a back or heels **higher than one inch are NOT permitted.**

NO athletic Shoes, October 1st - April 30th. (except for gym and dress down days)

WARM WEATHER UNIFORM - AUGUST, SEPTEMBER, MAY & JUNE FOR GRADES 1-8

Navy dress shorts or (girls skorts) with regular school tops. (Skorts must be at the fingertips when hands are held down at the side. **If a skort is too short, tights will be mandated after the first infraction.**)

Shorts/skorts must match Schoolbelles in style #3267, #3269, #3277, #8267 #8277, #8469 - color Navy

Boys in Grades 6-8 must wear belts.

OPTIONAL ITEMS - SWEATERS AND SWEATSHIRTS

Sweaters: Cardigan and V-neck in white, navy or grey.

Sweatshirts: All Saints sweatshirts (navy or grey) and hoodies (navy or grey) may be worn in classrooms during cold weather. All Saints sweatpants may be worn to school but not during the day under the uniform.

Hoodies may not be worn during liturgical celebrations in the chapel.

Other sweatshirts and sweatpants are not permitted in school. They may be worn to and from school, recess and gym class, but not as part of the uniform in school.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASSES (BOYS & GIRLS GRADES 1-8)

(All PE uniforms are available from the school.)

T-shirt: Gray All Saints. **Shorts:** Blue All Saints

Sweatpants: Gray All Saints (**required**); **Sweatshirt:** Gray All Saints (**optional**)-(Grades 1-4 October-April)

Shoes: Non-scuff gym shoes must be worn. **If wearing tennis shoes in school, students MUST BRING ANOTHER PAIR of shoes for gym.** **Deodorant:** Roll-on only (No aerosols)

Grades 1-4 - PE uniforms must be worn on designated gym days. Both the short set (warm weather months) and sweat clothes (cold weather months) are mandatory.

Students wear the PE uniform to and from school.

Grades 5-8 - Must bring their gym uniform and change into it at the Field House.

HAIRSTYLES

Hairstyles are to be simple and neat. Extreme hairstyles are not permitted for boys or girls. Hair should be its natural color and should not cover the eyes. Boys' hair should be no longer than their shirt collar and cut above their ears. No fad hairstyles are permitted. Tails, designs, lines, Mohawks, or partially shaved heads (shaved on the sides and long in front) are not permitted. Boys' front bangs, even though combed aside, should not be longer than the eyebrows. **Questionable styles, including color and length, will be left to the discretion of the administration. If in doubt, please call before changing hairstyles.**

DRESS DOWN DAYS

The school invites students to participate in occasional dress down days. Students' attire should always be modest and reflect Christian values. **Inappropriate clothing includes, but is not limited to:**

- ~ No shirts with inappropriate slogans or pictures, no spaghetti straps
- ~ No leggings, jeggings or yoga pants unless worn under a skirt or dress. Must be at the fingertips when hands are held down at the side.
- ~ No short shorts – Must be at the fingertips when hands are held down at the side. NO ROLLING.
- ~ Students should not dress down on scheduled Mass days.

Administration and faculty reserve the right to determine whether or not articles of clothing are considered inappropriate. In such cases a parent may be called to bring an appropriate change of clothes to school. **A repeat offense will result in not participating in future dress down days.**

CONDITION OF UNIFORM

The school uniform must always be worn in a manner that is appropriate for school. The uniform needs to be in good condition. All frayed material, markings and holes in the uniform are unacceptable. **Please replace uniform items as they become worn or the student outgrows them.**

THE ADMINISTRATION HAS THE FINAL SAY CONCERNING THE DRESS CODE.
